The Gospel (Mk 11, 1-10)

As the crowd drew near Bethphage and Bethany on the Mount of Olive, close to Jerusalem, Jesus sent off two of his disciples with the instruction: "Go to the village straight ahead of you, and as soon as you enter it you will find tethered there a colt on which no one has ridden. Untie it and bring it back. If anyone says to you, 'Why are you doing that?' say, 'The Master needs it but he will send it back here at once.'" So they went off, and finding a colt tethered out on the street near a gate, they untied it. Some of the bystanders said to them, "What do you mean by untying that colt?" They answered as Jesus had told them to, and the men let them take it. They brought the colt to Jesus and threw their cloaks across its back, and he sat on it. Many people spread their cloaks on the road, while others spread reeds which they had cut in the fields. Those preceding him as well as those who followed cried out: "Hosannah! Blessed be he who comes in the name of the Lord! Blessed be the reign of our father David to come! God save him from on high!" **This is the Gospel of the Lord**.
