Ice Cream Sandwich Cake

24 vanilla ice cream sandwiches

- 2 8 oz. whipped topping, thawed (such as Cool Whip)
- 1 12 oz. jar hot fudge ice cream topping
- 1 12 oz. jar caramel ice cream topping



1/2 cup chopped peanuts or pecans

Arrange 12 ice cream sandwiches in bottom of 9x13 dish. Top with layer of whipped topping, hot fudge topping and caramel topping. Repeat layering ending with whipped topping. Sprinkle with peanuts. Cover dish with aluminum foil and freeze until set, at least 30 minutes.

You can try different toppings such as mini M+M's, sprinkles, crushed Oreo cookies, toffee bits, etc.

Fishing Trip

The first of two Black Lake fishing trips took place in late June for Gerry and Frank Matla. A stay at the Watertown, NY Ramada with the New York National Guard was noteworthy. All the rain and the St. Lawrence rising flooded the eastern shore of Lake Ontario - the Watertown Promenade was flooded and the Guard was there to aid in evacuation of small shore communities of Henderson Harbor and Sandy Pond.

We arrived at our cabin on Saturday and the good fishing trip began. The lake was a bit high but the fishing was great. The first three days numerous bass in the 4 to 5 pound range were caught on plastic lures and crank baits. A weather front arrived on day four and the lake kicked up with rolling waves of two to three feet. Three trips were lost to unfishable conditions. However, by week's end Frank boated 150 fish and Gerry 120 large and small mouth bass, northern pike, perch and dogfish. Next a return in September for trip two. By Frank Matla
