The Gospel (Mk 4, 26-34)

He also said, "The kingdom of God is as if someone would scatter seed on the ground, and would sleep and rise night and day, and the seed would sprout and grow, he does not know how. The earth produces of itself, first the stalk, then the head, then the full grain in the head. But when the grain is ripe, at once he goes in with his sickle, because the harvest has come." He also said, "With what can we compare the kingdom of God, or what parable will we use for it? It is like a mustard seed, which, when sown upon the ground, is the smallest of all the seeds on earth; yet when it is sown it grows up and becomes the greatest of all shrubs, and puts forth large branches, so that the birds of the air can make nests in its shade." With many such parables he spoke the word to them, as they were able to hear it; he did not speak to them except in parables, but he explained everything in private to his disciples. **This is the Gospel of the Lord.**

From our Diocesan Bishop's email: "The upcoming Church programs through the year are scheduled during the summer months ahead: Kurs Youth Encampment and the biennial Youth Convocation (CONVO).

The annual Kurs Youth Encampment for youth ages 8 through 17 which will take place July 4th through 13th. Information and registration details are online at <u>https://www.kurscamp.org/</u>. The event will kick off with Holy Mass celebrated by Prime Bishop Anthony on Independence Day - a special day in the liturgical and historical life of our Holy Church. This year also marks the 95th anniversary of the dedication of Spojnia Farm. As part of the celebration, the Prime Bishop will bless the new 'Great Hall,' part of ongoing renovations at the Retreat and Recreation Center. It is a truly beautiful and remarkable restoration. The fees for PNCC youth will be covered by the Diocese as given above. However, costs for non-PNCC youth will not be covered. If you are familiar with people who send their children to Kurs, but who are not part of our Church, you would do very well to describe to them the kind of support which the greater Church provides for its affiliating members.

And finally, the biennial Youth Convocation (CONVO) will be held July 22nd through 26th with a theme from 1 Corinthians 9:24 "Running the Race." Convo 2024 will be held at Mercyhurst University in Erie, Pennsylvania. Information and registration forms are available at the Convo website here: <u>https://www.convo2024.com/</u>. Participants will create a diocesan flag to be carried during the opening ceremonies, as well as displayed at Convo. Youth and young adults ages 13 to 27 may attend. The Diocese will cover the CONVO registration cost for PNCC youth, young adults, adult escorts, and clergy of the Central Diocese. "
